We are battling through a few injuries at present, but the next-man-up mentality is something we are really honing this year!

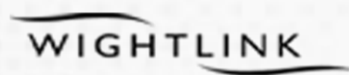

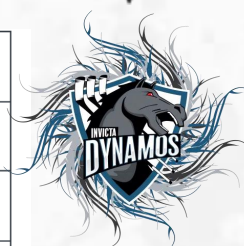
