A young and energetic team, Thunder have developed well this season. With the news that Coach Will Fry has siglong-term the end of 27/28 season, it's clear long term development is the team's main aim. 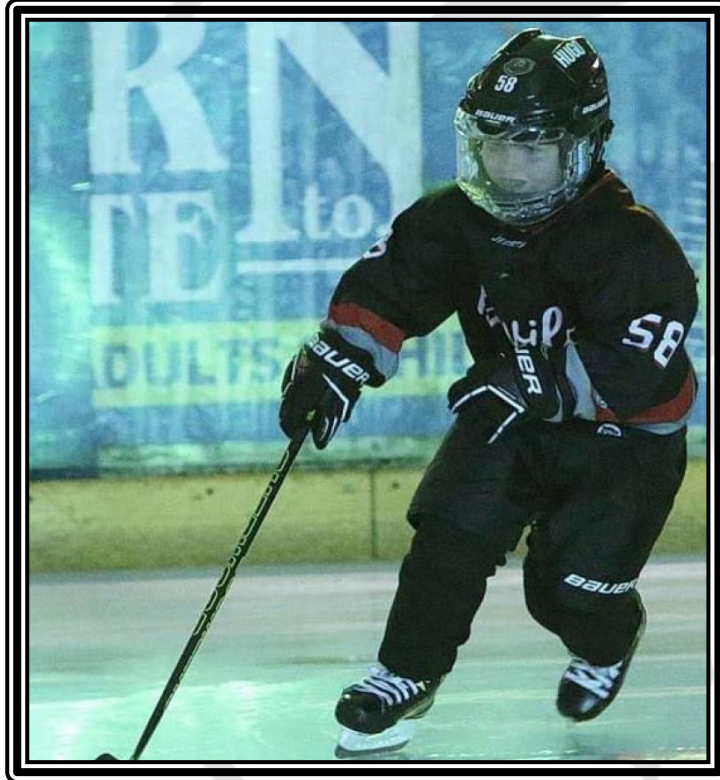
