It's Not All About Us

Swindon have strengthened their team since the beginning of the season and are now reaping the rewards. With the second half of the season firmly underway, Swindon will be looking to push for position and lock down a place in the Playoff Quarter Finals. Solid in defence and strong on the counter-attack, the Devils will need to be careful in attack not to invite Swindon to take control.

Warren currently leads the team in points, with 14 goals and 17 assists, and is likely to be a key player in any attacking opportunity the Wildcats take tonight, especially if paired with Turner or Sagan. Nethersell will be one to watch in defence, especially when it comes to creating the counter-attacking opportunities, as he sits second in the team on points, mostly made with his 17 assists, alongside Stone. Both these players will be hard to get past for a clear shot on goal. As a final hurdle, 17-year-old Clarke-Leach has proven himself to be an excellent choice for starting netminder, with a .901% save percentage, and having recently represented Team GB, he will be certainly be a troublesome final hurdle for any Devils' attack.
