# A Word From The Coach

Good evening, everyone and welcome to the Solent Arena as we welcome the players, staff and supporters of the Invicta Dynamos for tonight's League fixture.

This evening sees a big match-up in the context of the League, with 5<sup>th</sup> hosting 4<sup>th</sup>, and as always when we face Invicta, it promises to be a tight, hard-fought contest.

Our recent form has been a little mixed. Just before Christmas we put in one of our strongest performances of the season with an impressive League and Cup victory over Chelmsford, securing our place in the Cup Semi-Final, a result the group fully deserved. # It's Not All About Us

Following a home win against Slough in an action-packed match, as well as taking the points in their home games against the Devils this season, Invicta will be coming into this game confident. Form wise, they have won the last three encounters with the Devils and will be looking to take their current form further as the fight for league positioning starts to heat up. A fast paced and hard-hitting team, Invicta will seek to take control early and use that to fuel their momentum.

Connolly leads the team in points so far this season, with 13 goals out of 14 games, along with 7 assists, and is likely to be key to the Invicta plan, especially if paired with Pascale or Thune. Defensively, Tombs and Gatenby have the ability to not only disrupt attacks but also set up for Invicta counters. Divall has proven himself an accomplished shot stopper, starting 4 out of the 5 he's played so far and only letting in 4 goals out of 103 shots, giving an impressive 0.961% save percentage. Overall, this game is looking to promise the excitement this match-up has provided over the past couple of seasons.




