A Word From The Coach

Good evening and welcome to the Gosport Ice Arena as we host the Streatham RedHawks in tonight's NIHL 1 league fixture.

Last weekend was a disappointing one for us, picking up just one point from a possible six against teams currently below us in the league standings. Given the current situation within the group, that return was far from ideal, but it also served as a humbling reminder of where we are right now and the work still required.

There were positives to take, not least the return of Mark Pitts to the line-up, although unfortunately that comeback was short-lived following a setback on Saturday. The major talking point from the weekend, however, was the serious injury suffered by our leader and captain, Calumn, who sustained a collapsed lung in Sunday's away game against Romford. Seeing any player injured is difficult, but the severity of this incident really highlights the risks that come with playing our sport.

I would like to sincerely thank everyone for the incredible support shown to Calumn and his family over the past week. The messages, well-wishes and financial contributions to the GoFundMe page have been overwhelming, and they will make a genuine difference as Cal faces a long road to recovery. On behalf of the club, thank you.

Turning our attention to tonight, we face a very tough challenge. We are slightly light in numbers once again, but this also presents an opportunity for some of our younger players to step up and take on greater responsibility. We are determined to work hard and put in a performance for our supporters, who quite rightly have not had as much to celebrate as we would like this season.

Streatham are a top side with quality throughout their line-up, and we know that staying competitive, disciplined and resilient will be key. If we can keep the game close for as long as possible, we give ourselves the chance to make something happen.

Looking ahead, we have moved quickly to bring in several players to help cover the current injury situation, all of which were announced last night. Many are familiar faces, while others have joined us on two-way arrangements with our NIHL 2 team. We are hopeful they can make a positive impact when called upon and will be available as schedules allow moving forward.

As always, thank you for your continued support during a challenging period. The effort to move forward together remains strong.




