A Word From The Coach

Good evening, everyone and welcome to the Solent Arena as we face the Chelmsford Chieftains in tonight's NIHL 1 league fixture.

Last weekend saw us come up against a strong Streatham side, and while the final scoreline wasn't what we wanted, there were still positives to take. An inexperienced, young group eventually succumbed to Streatham's offensive power, but Rory was exceptional in goal, and it was great to see team debuts for Tre, Josh and Harry T. In particular, seeing Tre pull on the shirt was a proud moment given his long journey through our junior pathway. Results matter, and we're fully aware we need to bounce back quickly, but development and opportunity remain key pillars of what we're doing right now.

I also want to take a moment to mention Cal, who continues his recovery following his injury. He remains very much part of this group, and the messages of support he has received from across the hockey community have been incredibly powerful. We're all right behind him and look forward to seeing him back around the rink when the time is right.

Finally, a sincere thank you to our supporters. Your backing during a challenging period does not go unnoticed. The group is working tirelessly to turn performances into results, and your support gives the players an extra edge every time they step onto the ice.

We'll need you again tonight bring the noise and get behind the lads.
