A Word From The Coach

Good evening and welcome to the Gosport Ice Arena for tonight's NIHL 1 league fixture against the Slough Jets, and our special 90s themed dress-up night.

Last weekend we fell just short against a strong Chelmsford side. While the result didn't go our way, there were plenty of positives in the performance. The energy and application from the group was strong, and it was encouraging to see our younger players logging regular, meaningful minutes in key situations.

We also saw season debuts for Sutts, Adam Harris and Mitch, who slotted in well and added depth to the line-up. Ultimately, a handful of individual errors combined with clinical finishing from the Chieftains proved decisive. At this level, those fine margins matter and we were on the wrong side of them.

As things stand, we sit in 6th place, and realistically our focus now is on closing the gap to 5th and building performances that give us momentum heading into the playoffs. Results are important, but equally so is developing consistency and habits we can rely on when it matters most.

Tonight presents another major challenge. Slough are one of the strongest teams in the league and have had the better of us so far this season. They are fast, disciplined, and particularly dangerous on special teams. They're firmly in the hunt at the top end of the table, so we know exactly the level required.

Our squad remains stretched. Charlie and Cam are not quite ready to return, and our part-time players are unavailable this evening. That creates further opportunities for some of our NIHL 2 players to step in and gain valuable experience against elite opposition. It's a tough ask but it's also the kind of test that accelerates development.

Off the ice, we're looking forward to a great evening. With our 90s theme, glow-in-the-dark paint, lights and glow sticks on offer, we hope everyone embraces the occasion and enjoys the atmosphere. Hockey is about competition, but it's also about community and entertainment and tonight should have plenty of both.

It's a tough test, but one we're excited for.


