

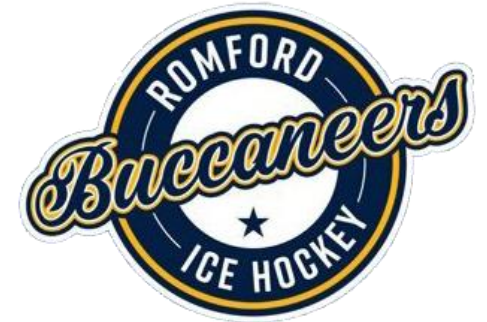

A Word From The Coach

Good evening and welcome to the Gosport Ice Arena for tonight's rearranged NIHL 1 league fixture against the Romford Buccaneers, originally postponed following the rink closure back in October.

Last weekend was a frustrating one in many ways. For 50 minutes we were right in the game and, in truth, I felt we outplayed Invicta for large spells. The return of Cam and Charlie made a real difference to our structure and balance, and it was encouraging to see us competing consistently against strong opposition. The disappointment was that we couldn't convert our chances. At this level, if you don't put the puck in the net, you don't get rewarded and that proved costly.

We now find ourselves in unfamiliar territory, sitting 7th in the table. Romford and Swindon above us continue to pick up points, which increases the pressure on every fixture. With six games remaining, I believe we need a minimum of 12 points to give ourselves a realistic shot at climbing back into 5th which remains our objective. There's no hiding from it; we have to start turning performances into results immediately.

Tonight won't be easy. Romford have been in strong form since the turn of the year. They've had solid goaltending, experienced players returning to their line-up, and the addition of two-way contracted Raiders from their National League side has strengthened them further. That's reflected in the standings.

But this is home ice, and it's an opportunity. We're desperate for the win, and the group knows exactly what's required discipline, urgency, and a willingness to do the hard details properly for 60 minutes.

As always, your support matters. We'll need the energy in the building tonight.

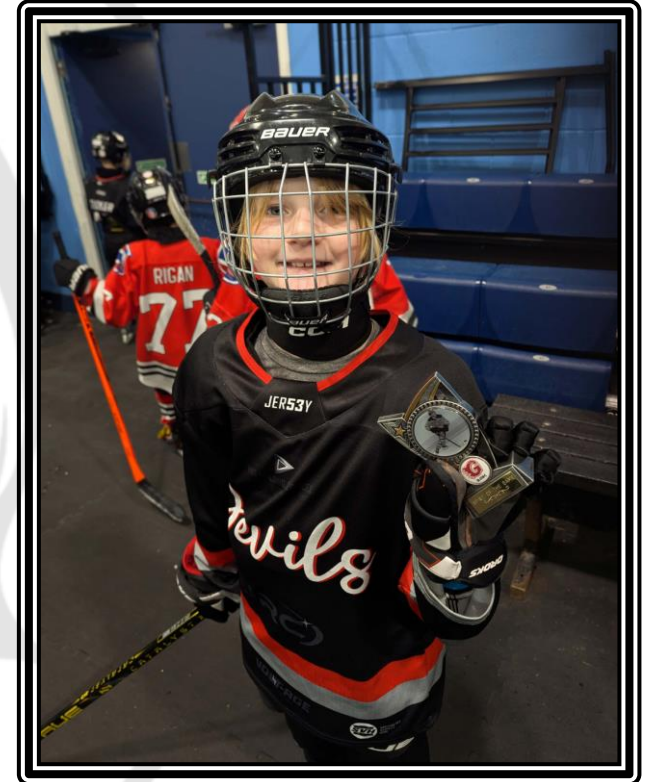
